## DRESS CODE POLICY

### 2025-2026

All attendees must wear appropriate business dress attire to the General Assemblies. Failure to comply with dress code standards will result in the delegate/advisor/guest not being allowed to enter the General Assembly.

Your advisor is responsible for enforcing their own expectations regarding dress code unless the clothing is strictly prohibited in this guide. The TJCSGA E-board suggests that you wear clothes that are professional and fit the standards of the convention.

#### General Guideline for all Members:

- All Attendees must wear an official convention badge at all times.

#### Inappropriate clothes will be defined as the following:

- Denim
- Sweatpants
- Spaghetti straps
- Exercise Pants
- Shorts
- Overalls
- Leggings
- Spandex
- Revealing clothing or clothing with holes
- Dresses and skirts less than an inch above the knee
- Shirts with potentially offensive words, terms, logos, pictures, cartoons, or slogans.
- Halter tops, muscle shirts, sweatshirts, and t-shirts
- Hats are not appropriate in the building. *\*Head covers that are required for religious purposes or to honor cultural traditions are allowed.*

#### SHOES:

- Shoes should be polished and professional looking.
- No flip flops, slides, house shoes, athletic shoes, or crocs.
- Door parliamentarians will have ultimate say as to what is allowed within the meeting room.

#### PERFUME/COLOGNE:

Should be in good taste and in moderation. Remember that some delegates are allergic to the chemicals in perfumes/cologne, so wear these substances with restraint.
